The Kings County Area Public Transit Agency ("Agency") is the Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the Federal Transit Agency (FTA) is the Lead Agency under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) for the proposed project identified below. The Agency is currently preparing an environmental document to determine the environmental effects of the proposed project, and we are notifying the public of this proposal transit project.

**ORGANIZATIONS AND INTERESTED PARTIES:** The Agency requests your comments and concerns regarding the environmental issues associated with the proposed Kings Area Rural Transportation (KART) Transit Station Project.

**Project:** KART Transit Station Project

**Project Description:** The proposed project consists of the development of a 19,000-square-foot transit station building, along with offsite parking, and onsite bus parking. The KART Transit Station would include a large central waiting area, break room, training room, in addition to office space leasable to tenants. The proposed project includes 21 sawtooth bus bays, 17 staff parking spaces, 8 secure staff parking spaces, and 105 park-and-ride spaces for transit users. Additionally, two electric bus chargers and two electric car chargers would be constructed onsite.

**Project Location:** East of Harris Street, west of Brown Street, north of East 7<sup>th</sup> Street, and south of the alley located between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be conducted in an open forum format. KCAPTA staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed project. A formal presentation will be made at approximately 5:30 p.m.

- Learn about upcoming deadlines on this project related to the environmental document.
- Ask questions about the project.
