RESOLUTION 27-02 NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE TRANSIT MAINTENANCE FACILITY

RESOLUTION #27-02

BEFORE THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE KINGS COUNTY AREA PUBLIC TRANSIT AGENCY

APPROVING THE FILING OF A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE RELATED DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Kings County Area Public Transit Agency ("KCAPTA") owns and operates the Transit Maintenance Facility located at 629 Davis Street in Hanford, CA, which serves as a transit maintenance, fueling, and fleet storage facility;

WHEREAS, KCAPTA proposed improvements including installation of thirteen (13) 180 kW zero-emission bus chargers with dual dispensers, battery energy storage systems (BESS), photovoltaic solar canopy structures, transformer and switchgear upgrades, conduit installation, trenching, paving, and electrical modifications to support zero-emission bus operations.

WHEREAS, all proposed improvements occur entirely within the existing KCAPTA-owned property and do not expand the operational footprint of the Transit Maintenance Facility.

a review of the project indicates it falls under the categorical exemption of PRC 2108.25 as amended by SB71.

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code §21080.25(b)(6), exempts public transit agency projects that construct or maintain infrastructure to charge or refuel zero-emission public transit buses when carried out on agency-owned property.

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code §21080.25(b)(7), exempts associated utility improvements including transformers, switchgear, conduit, trenching, battery storage, and solar canopy infrastructure essential for zero-emission transit operations.

WHEREAS, KCAPTA has determined that the Transit Maintenance Facility Zero-Emission Infrastructure Project is statutorily exempt under WHEREAS, Public Resources Code §21080.25(b)(6), exempts public transit agency projects that construct or maintain infrastructure to charge or refuel zero-emission public transit buses when carried out on agency-owned property PRC §21080.25(b)(6) & (b)(7).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the Board of Directors of the Kings County Area Public Transit Agency hereby approves the filing of a Notice of Exemption (NOE) pursuant to Public Resources Code §21080.25 for the Transit Maintenance Facility Zero-Emission Infrastructure Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: the Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the Notice of Exemption with the Kings County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse, and to take all necessary actions to implement this Resolution.
